

Have been working on the Remnant-TV site this afternoon – nearly ready to go with it, but cannot seem to find the correct place to activate the categories on the home page of the site.

I see in the Gallery plugin area, a place to sort those sections. And on that window that opens, I have "category" is turned on:

Good morning, Daniel –	

Also, as mentioned in item "F" early on in the email, any category with "0" for sort order should not be included in results anywhere on the page such as the left sidebar and the main view on the homepage. Can you look at that as well as the request from last night (categories not showing in the main area of the homepage).

I also do need a bit of assistance in understanding the plugin system. I was going to extend the Remnant Plugin that you created but not exactly sure how to hook it into an actual page. The target is the "subscribe" button as presented on a video page. Rather than using the built in function, I had changed the original site in such a way that when the subscribe button is clicked, a small dialog opens that includes a link to their main site to sign up for email notifications. The number of subscribers as shown on the site is the number on that mail list. Currently, the email system is from Active Campaign – I call their servers for that number via API. How to implement this?





Thanks Daniel -

On the categories, two distinctions:

- 1. For the suggested categories in the main view that's perfect. I'll add the ones intended to be there via the "suggested" function as outlined.
- 2. For the Categories in the sidebar nav area, need ALL categories to show there, except those with a sort order of zero. I found and reactivated the setting in CustomizeAdvanced/Advanced to turn them on in the left sidebar.

On the form below, under Privacy, can an option be added – maybe "Hidden", where if selected, it's hidden from the sidebar menu BUT still can be selected as "Suggested" AND the category be accessed if the full link is known (similar to a private video)?



- 3. On the subscribe button, I was able to find an option under Customize Advanced to turn it off for now. I'll send an separate email later about this exact need.
- 4. And I have the suggested categories worked out for the main view- new question for these categories, is there a way to influence the "Load More" function? That is, can I have 6 categories shown before the load more button is presented?

If we can get the category display worked out (#2), the site will be ready to go.


